Responsibilities

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, working in a team-based environment to support our work in advanced science research and to help provide students with the resources they need to succeed:

Specific duties include:

- Identify and develop systems to bring to the Manne Institute that can help students launch research projects.
- Represent the Manne Institute at various calls, conferences and meetings to help promote the research opportunities and strengthen partnerships.
- Work with students to develop their projects and to help with ideas, lab techniques and analysis.
- Adhere to all safety guidelines and ensure compliance. Participate in any trainings and certifications required for conducting advance research with secondary school students.
- Special projects as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- Background in the sciences is preferred;
- Minimum of 3 years experience in the scientific community;
- Demonstrated ability to design, implement and present lab-based scientific research projects;
- Candidates must be enthusiastic, organized, have strong interpersonal skills, have strong oral and written communication skills and be flexible in handling different situations.
- Knowledge of the Bronx High School of Science is preferred

Schedule and Compensation

This is a part-time position paid hourly. The compensation for this part-time role is \$25-\$30/hour, commensurate with experience, with the goal of at least 10 hours a week. This is an in-person position at the Manne Institute in the Bronx.
